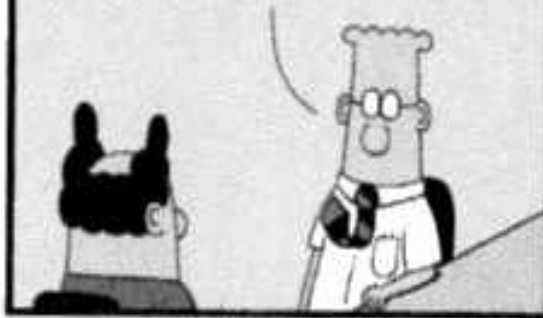

- EHSCP members approved formation at 2010 Conference
- EHSCP Industrial Hygiene Committee Formed early 2011
